

PFAS Statement

Whilst PFAS regulations are not due to enter into force until 2025/26 at Easby Electronics we understand that the regulations have the potential to impact future design and manufacturing decisions, and so may be an area of concern.

We can assure our customers that we understand our obligations as a supplier within the context of PFAS. As such we are conducting a material and production process review with our supply chain partners to understand the scale of PFAS in our products, and this will be an ongoing process as the regulations are finalised and enforcement dates are confirmed.

Easby continues to monitor potential regulatory, health & safety, and environmental impacts of the items we supply as part of our on-going product stewardship and regulatory compliance efforts. As such Easby routinely reviews material composition of our products against UK, European and Federal regulatory compliance requirements.
