



REACH Statement

Following the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union (and the end of the transition period), since 1st January 2021 both EU REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals) and UK REACH have been in force. UK REACH implements the EU regulation almost as it is.

Easby Group has verified both the EU and UK regulations to the best of its knowledge, and we believe none of the articles we sell intentionally contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) currently on the candidate list in concentrations of >0.1% by weight.

We review the SVHC lists each time they are published and poll our supplier base on a regular basis. All statements of conformity are made to the best of our knowledge with the information at our disposal at the time the declaration is made. Our declarations are only as accurate as the data received from our suppliers and as we are not the original manufacturer of the components, we do not perform physical testing on any of the products we distribute to validate the accuracy of the data received. As such we cannot accept liability for factors outside of our control.

We do not produce or import to the EU any substance in volumes that exceed one tonne per substance, and so are not required to register under EU REACH.

In accordance with article 33 of UK-REACH we provide information to our customers on products knowingly containing Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) over a limit of 0.1% by weight.
