



PFAS Statement

While PFAS regulations are constantly evolving, Easby Group understand that the regulations have the potential to impact future design and manufacturing decisions, and so may be an area of concern.

We can assure our customers that we understand our obligations as a supplier within the context of PFAS. As such we are conducting a material and production process review with our supply chain partners to understand the scale of PFAS in our products, and this will be an ongoing process as the regulations evolve. Some PFAS have already been categorised under UK REACH, EU REACH (EC 1907/2006) and EU POPs (EU 2019/1021) and we will continue to monitor these regulations and any other regulatory changes involving PFAS.

Easby continues to monitor potential regulatory, health & safety, and environmental impacts of the items we supply as part of our on-going product stewardship and regulatory compliance efforts. As such Easby routinely reviews material composition of our products against UK, European and Federal regulatory compliance requirements.

All statements of conformity are made to the best of our knowledge with the information at our disposal at the time the declaration is made. Our declarations are only as accurate as the data received from our suppliers and as we are not the original manufacturer of the components, we do not perform physical testing on any of the products we distribute to validate the accuracy of the data received. As such we cannot accept liability for factors outside of our control.
