



RoHS & WEEE Directives Statement

The Easby Group recognises its responsibilities to the environment as well as its customers. With the advent of the RoHS (2015/863) amendment of the RoHS DIRECTIVE 2011/65/EU, RoHS-Recast, Article 4(1), China RoHS: (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) and WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) directives, the Group has reviewed its processes to ensure it is able to assist customers to meet their responsibilities regarding these directives.

The substances and restriction thresholds covered under this directive are:

- Lead(Pb) : 0.1%
- Mercury(Hg): 0.1%
- Cadmium(Cd): 0.01%
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) : 0.1%
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): 0.1 %
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): 0.1 %
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): max 0.1%
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): max 0.1%
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): max 0.1%
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): max 0.1%

The Easby Group designates products as RoHS, RoHS2 and RoHS3 compliant based on information provided by its suppliers. RoHS/RoHS2 and RoHS3 compliant means that the supplier has confirmed the compliance of the relevant products either because they do not contain any of the restricted substances referred to at concentrations more than those permitted under the RoHS Directives or unless allowed under exemption for the applications listed in the Annex to the Directives.

All statements of conformity are made to the best of our knowledge with the information at our disposal at the time the declaration is made however, our declarations are only as accurate as the data received from our suppliers and as we are not the original manufacturer of the components, we do not perform physical testing on any of the products we distribute to validate the accuracy of the data received. As such we cannot accept liability for factors outside of our control.
